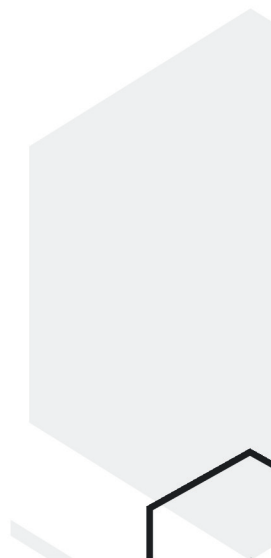
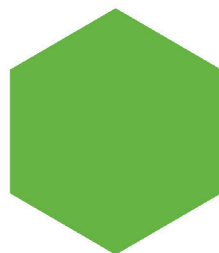

WHAT ACCOUNTS DO WE OFFER?

At Newark Motor Auctions, we offer different account types to suit your needs. Whether you're buying for personal use or as a business, see below to find out what accounts you can open and the benefits of each.

PRIVATE ACCOUNT

- Standard buyer's fees
- Access to in hall bidding only
- Deposit to be paid once bid has been won

TRADE ACCOUNT

- Trade buyer's fees*
- Access to in hall & free access to online bidding

*To qualify for a trade account, you must be VAT registered and the ability to provide relevant documentation upon registration.

5. MAIN CAR PARK

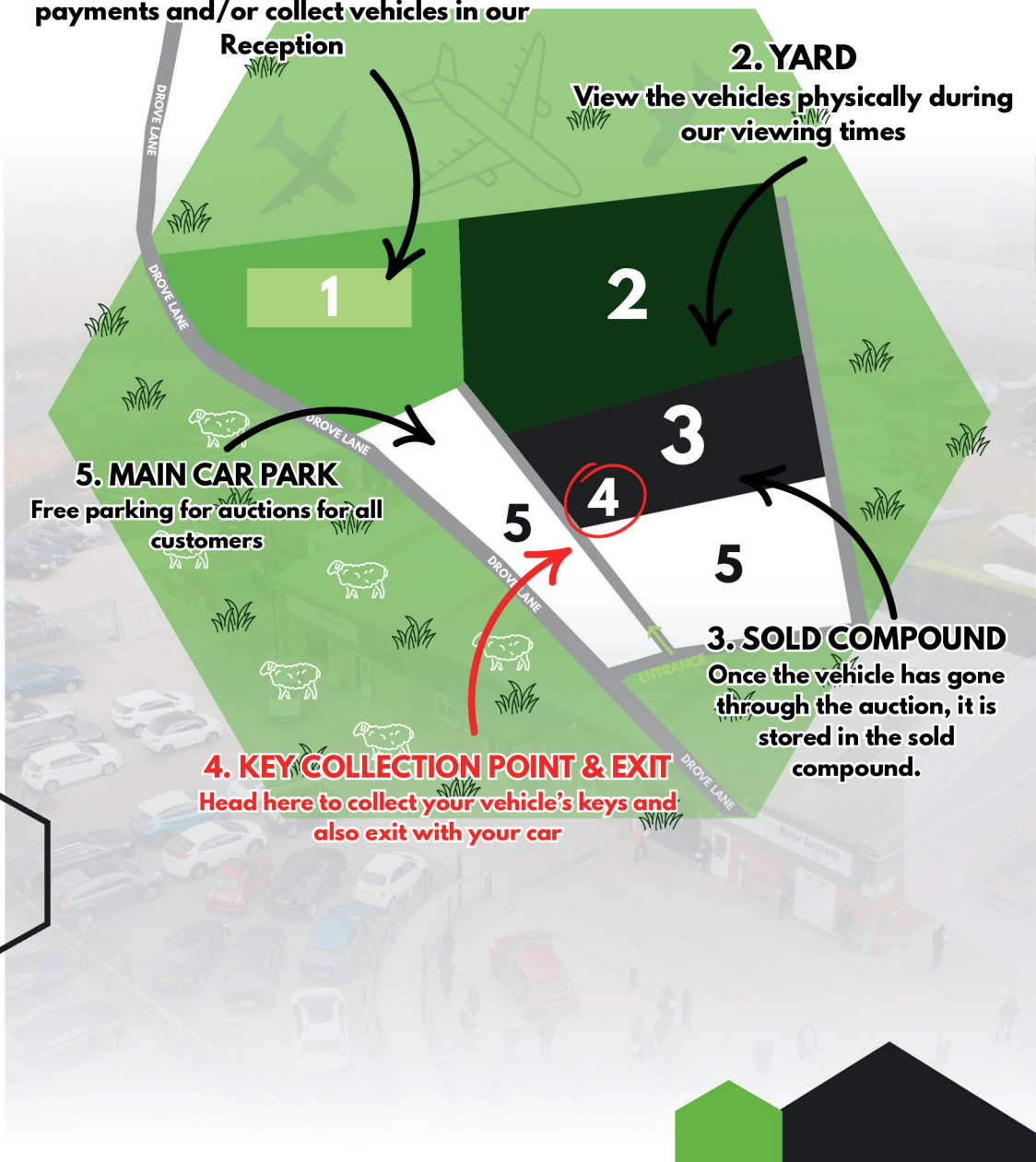
Free parking for auctions for all customers

CHECKING IN FOR BIDDING



To participate in our auctions, you'll need to check in and register as a bidder. The process is quick and simple, ensuring that you're all set to place your bids when the auction begins. Here's everything you need to know...

REGISTRATION DESK

Upon arrival, head to our Reception. If you're already registered in our system, simply inform a staff member that you're here to bid, and they will check you in and issue your bidding number. If you're a first-time bidder, don't worry – our welcoming team will be happy to assist you with the registration process.

BIDDING NUMBER

Once registered, you'll be issued a bidder number. This unique number will be used to place your bids throughout the auction. Keep it handy at all times, as you'll need to present it when you're ready to bid on your desired lots.

HOW TO BID

Once the auction begins, you can place your bids by raising your bidder number when you want to make an offer on the vehicle under the rostrum. Our auctioneers will call for bids and take note of your number when you're successful. Be sure to keep your number visible so the auctioneer can see it clearly.

DEPOSIT

If you're successful in winning a lot, you will be required to pay a deposit immediately after you have won the vehicle. The amount to be paid is 10% of the hammer price with a minimum of £300. This deposit will secure your purchase until full payment is made.

PAYMENT OF VEHICLES

We aim to make your purchasing experience as smooth as possible. After successfully winning a lot, you will need to settle payment according to the following guidelines:

We need two separate forms of ID:

1. Photo ID (UK driving license or Passport)
2. Proof of Address (bank statement or utility bill dated within the last 3 months)

IMPORTANT: YOU MUST PROVIDE US WITH YOUR ID FOR OUR RECORDS. THIS IS A DVLA REQUIREMENT WE MAKE NO APOLOGIES FOR.

Once your ID is provided, our team will make a copy and authorise the release of the vehicle documents to you.

PAYING FOR YOUR VEHICLE

Payment for the vehicle must be paid within 24 hours of purchasing the vehicle. We accept the following methods of payment at our auction house:

- Cash (up to £8,500 per day)
- Personal debit cards
- Bank transfer

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING:

- CREDIT CARDS
- BUSINESS DEBIT CARDS

Once payment has been accepted, you will be given your invoice and can now collect the vehicle.

NMA REQUIRES PAYMENT WITHIN 24 HOURS AND COLLECTION WITHIN 72 HOURS. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN A £10 PER DAY STORAGE FEE BEING APPLIED TO THE VEHICLE.

IF THE VEHICLE IS NOT FULLY PAID FOR WITHIN 7 DAYS OF PURCHASE, YOUR BIDDING PRIVILEGES WILL BE BLOCKED. THE VEHICLE WILL BE RE-ENTERED INTO THE AUCTION, AND ANY PAID DEPOSIT OR FEES WILL BE FORFEITED. PLEASE ENSURE ALL PAYMENTS & COLLECTIONS ARE MADE WITHIN THE SPECIFIED TIME FRAME TO AVOID ANY INCONVENIENCE.

COLLECTION OF VEHICLES

You can now collect your vehicle from Newark Motor Auctions. Simply follow the instructions below for a smooth collection process.

Our team will issue you with a pass-out, which is required to collect your vehicle. Please make sure all necessary fields are completed before collection (see example below):

TO COLLECT VEHICLE

Please head to the vehicle collection point located in the sold compound. Hand your pass-out to a team member, who will provide you with the keys and stamp your pass-out. Once stamped, locate your vehicle and drive it to the exit next to the collection point. Hand your stamped pass-out to the team member at the exit to complete the process and leave the site.

BIDDER'S DICTIONARY

New to auctions or want to brush up on your terminology? Our Bidder Dictionary explains the most common phrases and terms used at Newark Motor Auctions, so you can bid with confidence and speak like a pro.

SOLD AS SEEN

The vehicle is sold in its current condition, and the buyer accepts it without any guarantees or warranties. It's important to inspect the vehicle carefully before bidding.

CAVET EMPTOR

Latin for "let the buyer beware." It means it's the BUYER'S responsibility to check the condition and history of the vehicle before purchasing.

PROVISIONAL

A lot marked as provisional means a bid has been placed, but it is awaiting the vendor's confirmation. The sale isn't final until the vendor accepts the bid.

INCORRECT MILEAGE

All mileages are sold as incorrect, meaning we do not guarantee the accuracy of the vehicle's mileage. It's the BUYER'S responsibility to verify any discrepancies, including checking government records or vehicle history.

CATEGORY

These terms refer to insurance write-off categories. Cat N means the vehicle has non-structural damage that can be repaired without affecting the frame, while Cat S indicates structural damage that requires repairs to the chassis or frame before the vehicle is safe to drive.

TOP TIPS

To help you get the most out of your auction experience, we've put together some essential tips and advice. Read on below to make informed bids and enjoy a smooth, successful auction day.

GO TO A FEW AUCTIONS WITHOUT BUYING FIRST

Attend a few auctions without bidding to get a feel for how the process works.

TURN UP EARLY ON THE DAY

Arriving early gives you time to register, view lots, and plan your strategy.

RESEARCH THE VEHICLE

Check all available details about the car you're interested in. Remember, we do not guarantee mileage or comment on government history, so it's your responsibility to verify any discrepancies.

SET A STRICT BUDGET

Decide in advance how much you're willing to spend and stick to it to avoid overspending.

DON'T FORGET TO FACTOR IN BUYER'S FEES

Always include the buyer's fee when calculating your total costs.

Remember to be polite and respectful to both staff and fellow bidders. Maintain a calm and professional attitude, follow instructions from the auctioneer, and keep your bids clear. Good manners help make the auction a smooth and enjoyable experience for everyone.

BUYERS' FEES

When you win a lot at Newark Motor Auctions, a buyer's fee is added to the final hammer price. This fee covers the costs of running the auction and is separate from your bid amount. Please take this into account when setting your budget, as it contributes to the total amount payable for your vehicle.

WE OFFER ONLINE BIDDING

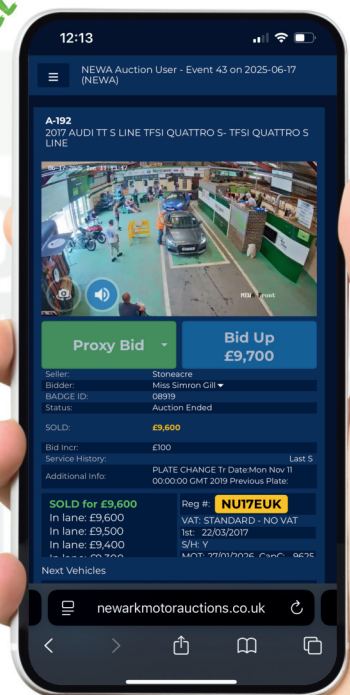
Can't make it to the auction in person? With Live Bid, VAT-registered traders can participate in our Tuesday morning auction online from anywhere. It's simple, convenient, and there's no fee to use the platform.

To use Live Bid, you must first register for a Live Bid account and provide proof of your VAT registration.

Once approved, you can browse the available lots, track the auction in real time, and place your bids just like you would on-site. Keep an eye on the bidding, set your limits, and follow all auction rules to secure the vehicles you want.

Live Bid allows you to join the auction from home, the office, or on the go - **all at no extra cost, completely free for traders.**

DELIVERY STRAIGHT TO YOUR DOOR

At Newark Motor Auctions, we offer a reliable delivery service to get your purchased vehicles to you safely and conveniently. Whether you're local or further afield, we'll help make collection simple.

Once your vehicles are paid for, our team can arrange delivery to your chosen address. We have a fleet ranging from smaller HGV's to large articulated lorries, allowing us to transport vehicles of all sizes.

Delivery times will be confirmed at the point of booking, and all costs will be clearly communicated before the vehicle is dispatched.

While we take care to ensure vehicles are delivered safely, it is the buyer's responsibility to provide accurate delivery details and to be available to receive the vehicle.

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CAVET EMPTOR

The vehicles offered by vendors today are not presented as instant bargains. The stock may have been rejected or disposed of for various reasons.

At a franchised dealer or reputable showroom, you can expect guarantees or warranties – however, no such assurances are provided at a public auction.

All vehicles are presented on behalf of the vendor. Until the fall of the hammer, the vehicle remains the property of the vendor. Once the hammer falls, ownership transfers to you, the buyer. Mechanical or cosmetic issues may arise at any time. Our voluntary code means we will only demonstrate that the vehicle engages in first and reverse gear.

NMA does not check or verify vehicle mileages. It is the buyer's sole responsibility to carry out all necessary checks, including mileage verification, prior to bidding.

You must conduct your own due diligence before placing a bid. NMA accepts no responsibility for any faults, defects, or discrepancies after the sale.
